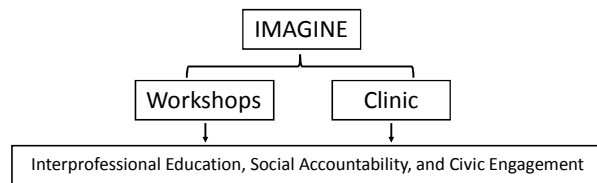

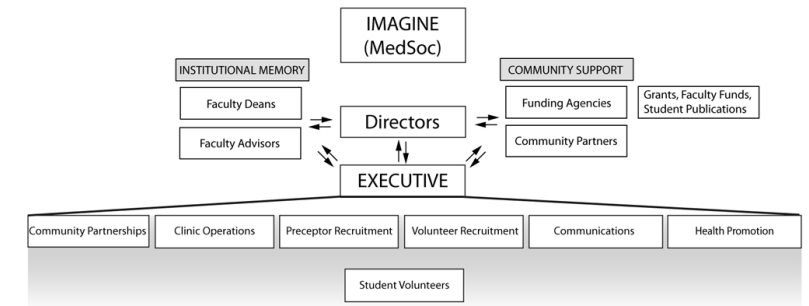


Workshops

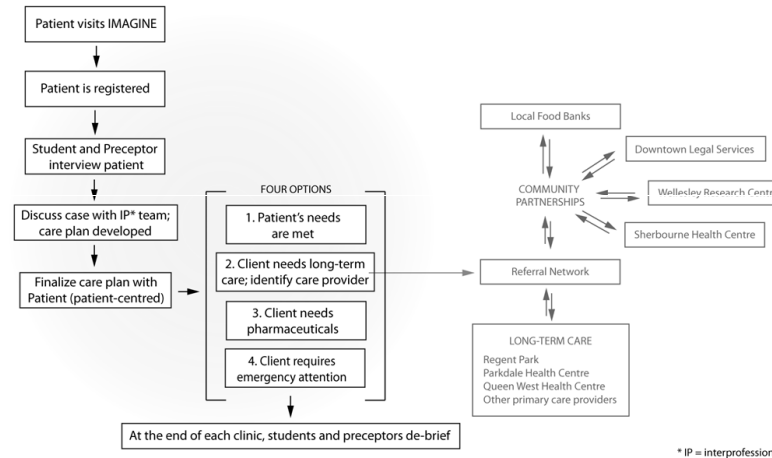
